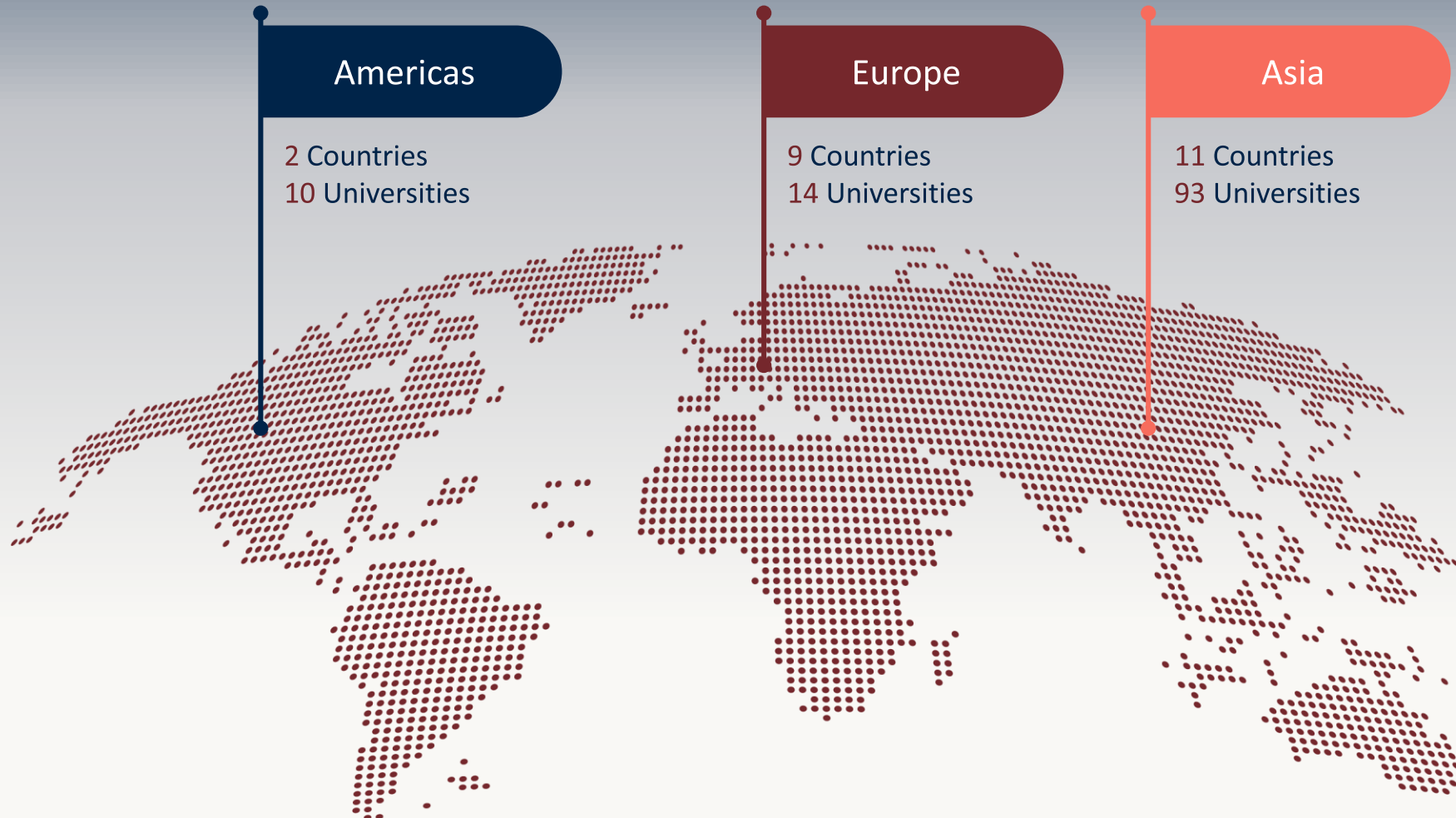

Application Procedure

Nomination Deadline: Nov 1st for spring semester, May 1st for fall semester

Application Deadline: Nov 15th for spring semester, May 15th for fall semester

Language Requirements: Certificate of language proficiency:
English (TOEFL IBT 61, IELTS 5.0, etc.) or
TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) 4 Level or
proof of min. 2 Korean courses completed

Visa Requirements: D-2 Visa

Duration of Process: 1 month

1. Mentoring
