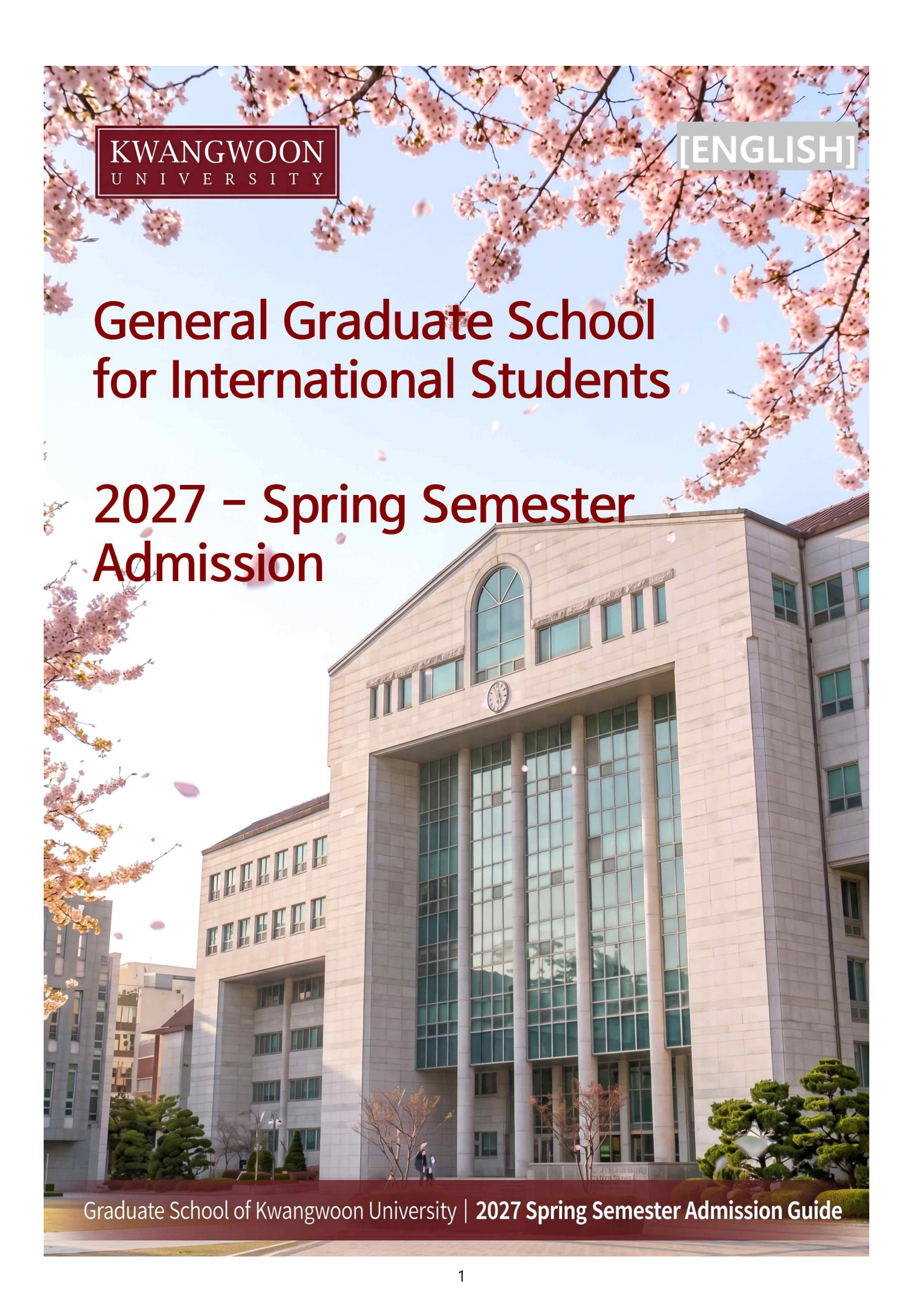

5. Notes for Applicants

- ▶ [Submission Method] Documents must be submitted by mail or in person. Submissions that do not arrive by the specified deadline will be excluded from evaluation (Individual confirmation of mail delivery is not available).
- ▶ [General Principles] All documents must be original and issued within the last 3 months from the submission date. Submitted documents and application fees are non-refundable. For provisional graduation certificates and final academic certificates, and transcripts only originals with Apostille authentication are valid.
- ▶ [Translation & Notarization] Documents in languages other than Korean or English must be translated by a professional translator or agency, followed by mandatory notarization.
- ▶ [Personal Information] The English name and date of birth on the application must exactly match those on the passport.
- ▶ [Prospective Graduates] Accepted applicants who are expected to graduate must submit their graduation certificate by Friday, February 12, 2027. (If issuance is delayed, a Provisional Certificate stating the expected date of issuance may be submitted first, followed by the final version immediately upon issuance.)
- ▶ [Additional Requirement for Admitted Students] Admitted students must resubmit an original bank balance certificate issued after Dec. 2026.
- ▶ [Cancellation of Admission] Failure to submit documents, document forgery or alteration, or failure to meet application qualifications may result in application rejection or admission cancellation (including failure to submit the final graduation certificate after submitting a provisional certificate).
- ▶ [Additional Guidance] Additional documents may be requested separately if necessary beyond the guidelines above.

6. Apostille and Notarization

※ [Verification of Academic Credentials] - Diploma, Expected & Final graduation certificate, and Transcripts

- **Non-Chinese Nationals:** Submit the Expected or Final graduation certificates and transcripts with the <Apostille Confirmation> issued by the government agency of the relevant country, or submit the <Consular Confirmation> or <Overseas Educational Institution Confirmation> at the Korean consulate located in the relevant country.
- **Chinese Nationals:** Submission of Graduation certificates, and transcripts <Verification Report> or <Apostille Confirmation>.

- ▶ Since obtaining an Apostille or verification report takes at least 30 days, applicants must apply and prepare them in advance before submitting the application.
- ▶ Submitted certificates will not be returned. Documents required for visa issuance or change must be prepared separately by the applicant.

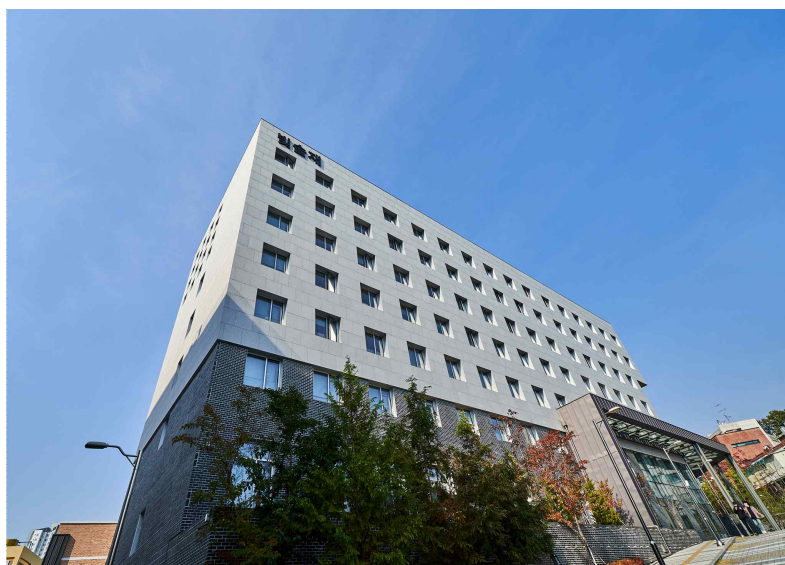
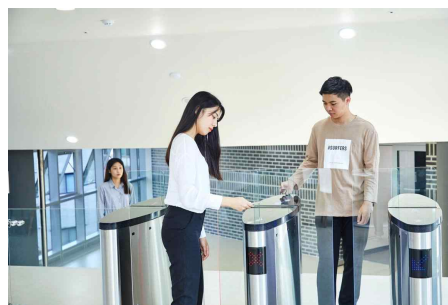
